Evansville Retired Teachers Association Executive Board Meeting December 1, 2022

<u>Call to Order</u>: President Jan Craig called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m. at Embrace Church and welcomed everyone. In addition to the president, the following were in attendance: Lynn Arteberry, Karen Bippus, Fred Bullinger, Judy Isaac, Janet Leistner, Diana Luck, Donna Lutz, Diane Meier, and David Pfettscher. Sandra Schmidt attended by phone.

Approval of October 6, 2022, Executive Board Minutes: The minutes were accepted as written.

Officer Reports:

<u>Treasurer</u>: Lynn Arteberry gave the following financial report as of November 30, 2022:

Checking Account: \$4,895.42 Savings Account: \$240.90 Scholarship Account: \$12, 319.24

Total Assets: \$17, 455.56

Lynn also reported that ERTA now has a policy through Shepherd Insurance for the bonding of the treasurer at the cost of \$147 for one year.

<u>President-elect</u>: Jan reported for President-elect Doris Beard. Currently there are 102 reservations for lunch. Poinsettias donated by the EVSC Board will decorate the tables. One member at each table will take a poinsettia home.

<u>Past President</u>: Janet Leistner announced that the Special Project money from Frog Follies, totaling \$1,317.28, is being awarded to the United Methodist Home.

Janet also announced that there are plans for a committee to revisit the ERTA Bylaws in January or February.

<u>President</u>: A collection box will be on each luncheon table for members who wish to donate to the president's selected non-profit. Last year the Tri-State Food Bank was the recipient. No decision as to this year's recipient has been made yet.

Committees:

<u>Community Service</u>: Forms will be on the luncheon tables for the members to report their volunteer hours. The Indiana Legislature is made aware of the number of hours that teachers volunteer.

Fellowship/Necrology: Donna Lutz updated those in attendance on cards she had sent to members.

<u>Membership</u>: Janet announced that 247 have renewed their membership at this time She added that 52 have not responded. Janet said that she will be sending out a new membership list.

Publications: It was noted that our newsletter follows state standards.

<u>Scholarships</u>: Diane Meier reported that some Hensley recipients are no longer teaching. She plans to send out more confirmations this summer. She also reported that Mike Kelly would like to attend the National

Science Teachers Conference in March. The cost for registration, travel, hotel, and meals adds up to \$1,805.00. The committee's recommendation is to award this amount so Mike can attend the conference. Diane added that before deducting the \$1,805.00, the Hensley fund total is \$10, 470.19.

Old Business:

<u>United Way Grants</u>: Janet reported that a review of applications has been completed by a committee. The committee made suggestions after meeting eight to ten times. United Way will decide which applications to fund.

New Business:

Reception for New Retirees: A reception for new retirees will be held in early May at EVSC. Janet asked if ERTA could attend. ERTA has been given permission to attend to acquaint the new retirees with our organization. Jan said that she would like to make a banner. Fifty dollars is needed for supplies. Diane made a motion for \$50 to be allocated for supplies. Judy seconded the motion. The motion passed.

<u>Nominating Committee</u>: Doris Beard will be meeting with the committee, so a slate can be presented to the ERTA Board at the March meeting.

Announcement: The next ERTA Executive Board Meeting will be on Thursday, March 2, 2023, at 1:00 p.m.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 1:56 p.m.
